Concept Wordlist and Guidelines for Compilers of Bilingual Dictionaries

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Foreword

The purpose of this list is to provide the lexicographer with a checklist of words and concepts when compiling a bilingual dictionary. It is specifically intended to be used with those languages and dialects where no standard or reliable monolingual dictionary exists. The list can also be used to insure that basic words, sometimes overlooked, are included.

The ultimate goal is to provide framework within which the a lexicographer can organize а fundamental approach to entry selection. It is intended to inspire the lexicographer to go far beyond meanings cited by working the carefully and imaginatively within each area. For example, in the number 32 series, only basic foods are listed, local names for various recipes, spices, and condiments should be sought and included.

Organization by meaning is always subject to dispute. Is a chicken to be considered a BIRD (03.3) or DOMESTICATED FOWL (03.4)? If the latter, should it be put within the section on ANIMALS or on FARMING? No matter which decision is made, something is gained and something lost as a result.

Meanings have been organized so that whole areas that are less relevant can be de-emphasized or ignored, such as 01.2 COLD CLIMATE in tropical areas, 02.2 OCEAN TOPOGRAPHY in inland or desert areas, and so on. If a category is culturally relevant to your language, work within it and beyond it to the extent of the overall goals of your dictionary project (i.e., beginning, intermediate or advanced). If partially or totally irrelevant, instead of engaging in laborious translations of the English concept, skip the item(s) in question.

An English index is supplied so that the user can check quickly if a meaning has been covered, and, if one is making an English to Target Language dictionary, to have a pattern or guide.
