



The Banton branch of the Bisayan languages (Zorc 1977) was renamed Asi in a joint publication (Zorc-Lobel-Hall, to appear) due to the fact that the name Banton does not geographically represent the areas wherein the languages are spoken. Jason Lobel has done more work on the Bisayan languages (2013) which made it possible to update the Zorc 1977 tree model. The above tree/rake/fan model was created by comparing the tree/rake/fan model in the Zorc 1977 dissertation with the data presented in the Lobel 2013 dissertation, and consulting with both authors as to the correctness of the representation of the tree/rake/fan model.
