

AN EXTENDED PROTO-MANOBO WORD LIST

1. INTRODUCTION

Comparative studies of the Manobo subfamily of Philippine languages have resulted in a number of Proto-Manobo reconstructions (Elkins 1974, Harmon 1974, Elkins 1982). The present paper is intended to extend the list of Proto-Manobo forms beyond the basic vocabulary reconstructed earlier.

Subgrouping theories based on comparative data (Elkins 1974) and on lexicostatistics (Walton 1979) provide a basis for the reconstructions presented here. In the trees constructed by Elkins and by Walton, the only node shared by the northern and southern subgroups is the node at the Proto-Manobo level. At the present time these two subgroups are widely separated geographically with little possibility for mutual borrowing. Also, language contacts for the two subgroups have not been similar. Because of this, it does not seem likely that a significant number of cognates exists which are the result of borrowing. From this we infer that when cognates are found, they most likely reflect true Proto-Manobo forms.

The two languages on which the majority of reconstructions are based are Cotabato Manobo of the southern subgroup and Binukid of the northern subgroup. Speakers of Cotabato Manobo live on or near the south coast of Mindanao in the northern part of the province of Bukidnon. Reconstruction of an extended list of Proto-Manobo forms has been made possible by the recent availability of dictionaries in these two languages.¹

The languages which have been major sources of borrowings in Cotabato Manobo have been Maguindanao, Tiruray, and Tboli. Binukid has been considerably influenced by Cebuano Visayan, and to a much lesser degree, by other nearby Manobo languages and by Maranao.

Included in the extended list of reconstructions are Proto-Manobo forms previously reconstructed by Elkins (1974, 1982). Cited with the list are Proto-Philippine forms and certain supporting evidence supplied by David Zorc. Some are from his *Proto-Philippine Finder List* (1971) and others are from his data files. I am grateful to him for permission to include those forms with the list.²

520. work *baqeł. BKD baqal; CTM baqel; PSP *baʔel 'work (the fields)' (Ceb baʔúl 'field, dry farm').
521. wound *paliq. BKD, CTM paliq; PSP *pali?. (Ceb palí?, Tir fáli?).
522. wrap; bundle *putus. BKD, CTM putus; PPH *putus.
523. wrap in a leaf *lepet. BKD, CTM lepet.
524. wrap with a cord *kedked. BKD, CTM kedked.
525. year *tuqig. BKD, WBM, DIB tuqig; PSP *tuʔig.¹²
526. yesterday; past *gabiq(i). BKD gabiq; TIG, DIB gabiqi; SAR gebiqi; PPH *Rabiʔih 'night'; *ka-Rabiʔih 'yesterday, last night'.

3. APPENDIX

The following is a list of loans or suspected loans. The reconstructions, therefore, do not indicate true Proto-Manobo. For this reason they are marked by an x superscript instead of *. They are given here to show the correspondences.

anvil xrandasan. BKD, CTM landasan; WBM rendasan. Probably from Malay.

brass xgalang. BKD, CTM galang. Probably from Malay gálaŋ.

clairvoyance xqalamat. BKD qalamat; CTM qalemat. A loan from Arabic probably via Malay.

¹¹ PSP *salepan is a more likely source for the PMb reconstruction because otherwise we have an irregular Manobo *l where we would expect *d or *r (Zorc).

¹² PMb *tuqig may be a widespread loan from Cebuano (Zorc).

PROTO-MANOBO WORD LIST

- cotton ^xgapas. BKD, CTM gapas. Said to be a loan from Indic languages, cf. Hindi kapas 'cotton tree'.
- craftsman ^xpanday. BKD, CTM panday. A loan via Malay from Sanskrit pandya 'learned, wise'.
- crafty ^xqakal. BKD, CTM qakal. A widespread Philippine loan from Malay akal which is derived from Arabic aqala 'have intelligence'.
- lack ^xkurang. BKD, CTM kulang; WBM kurang. Probably a loan from Malay.
- onion grass ^xganda(h). BKD ganda; CTM gandah. Ultimately from Sanskrit gandha- 'smell, odour'.
- read ^xbasa. BKD, CTM basa. Ultimately from Sanskrit vacas 'word' via Malay oaca.
- scratch with the feet ^xkahir. BKD, CTM kahil; WBM kahir. The Manobo forms are suspect Malay loans. The reconstruction should be *kahiR. Hence if cognate in Manobo, the forms should all be kahig.
- thousand ^xlibu. BKD, TIG, DIB, WBM. A widespread borrowing via Malay ribu from PHN *Ribu.
- thread ^xtanul. BKD, CTM tanul. Probably a borrowing via Danawan languages (cf. Mar tanor). The PPH reconstruction is *tanud (Ceb tanud, Kor-Blaan tanol 'thread', Kalinga tānud 'needle').
- trousers ^xsalu(q)al. TIG saluqal; SAR selowal; DIB sauqaa; KIN sawal; TAG saruqal.
- wag the tail ^xqikulqikul. BKD, CTM qikulqikul. Probably a loan from Malay ekor from PMP *ikuR 'tail'.
- water buffalo ^xkarabaw. BKD, CTM kalabaw; WBM keravew. All Philippine forms are suspect of being from Malay, since other AN data point to a reconstruction *kaRbaw (which would yield Mb *kagbaw).
- write ^xsurat. BKD, CTM sulat; WBM surat. A borrowing from Malay surat and ultimately from PHN *suRat 'cut, wound; (by extension) write'; see #213, PMB PMb *sugat 'hit a mark'.
